Program of the event:

Thursday, 17 May 2018:

From 15:00: Arrival and check in at Schloss Hünigen in CH-3510 Konolfingen 18:30: Reception and welcome aperitif (Offered by Rover Club Schweiz)

19:30: Dinner at the restaurant of Schlosshotel Hünigen

Thursday is optional but it offers good opportunities, to meet with Rover Friends of the past and enjoying a nice meal together followed by bar visit where you can enjoy cocktails or drinks.

Friday, 18 May 2018

Up to 09:00: Arrival and check in at Schloss Hünigen (latecomers) in

09:30: Morning briefing; Thereafter start to our tour through the Emmental. First we will visit the E-Bike factory "Flyer" in Huttwil. Then we will continue our drive and head towards Affoltern to visit the Schaukäserei where they make the famous Emmentaler.

- ca. 14:30: A local guide will take us through the cheese dairy where you learn how the big holes come into the Emmentaler cheese ©
- ca. 16:00 Return back to our hotel.

Saturday, 19 May 2018

- 09:30: Morning briefing; Thereafter we will start our tour through the Gürbetal. The Gürbetal area is famous for producing white cabbage, which after harvesting, is turned into Sauerkraut.
- 10:00: Viewing of the Oldtimer Galerie in Toffen. A place well known for its Classic Cars and Bikes auctions. There is a permanent display of about 120 cars and bikes on an area of 3'000 m2.

13:30: Our cars stay at the Oldtimer Galerie's car park in Toffen. We change to a vintage coach made by Swiss coach and truck manufacturer Saurer to take us to Berne.

14:00: UNESCO Old town tour. In 1983 the old town of Berne has been accepted on the list of world cultural assets of UNESCO. Back to medieval times the city is well documented and is based on plans of this era.



15:30: Stopover at the old tramway depot. A meeting point for young and old likewise. For more than 15 years, it has been an important location in Berne where their in-house brewed beer is served.

ca. 16:30: Ride back to Toffen in the Vintage Saurer Coach.

After: Return back to Schloss Hünigen in our own cars.

19:00: Gala-Dinner at the Schlosshotel

Sunday, 20 May 2018:

10:30: Schloss brunch with a rich and exclusive buffet including warm and cold dishes at the restaurant Rosarium.
